 - 2.(b) The age of the minor.
 - (3) OFFENSES AND PENALTIES.-
 - (a) A person may not:
- 1. Knowingly exhibit for a monetary consideration to a minor or knowingly sell or rent a videotape of a motion picture to a minor or knowingly sell to a minor an admission ticket or pass or knowingly admit a minor for a monetary consideration to premises whereon there is exhibited a motion picture, exhibition, show, representation, or other presentation which, in whole or in part, depicts nudity, sexual conduct, sexual excitement, sexual battery, bestiality, or sadomasochistic abuse and which is harmful to minors; or
 - 2. Knowingly exhibit to a minor a drag performance.
